Duties and Responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Help administer the club's online member registration and orientation system• Welcome SCC members as they arrive at the boathouse and answer questions they may have• Help members select appropriate paddling equipment and adjust it for their use• Organize and deliver boathouse tours to new members• Lead informal 2-hour Recreation Division group paddling sessions on the South Saskatchewan River• Lead short information/demonstration sessions on entry-level paddling topics for members• Inspect paddling equipment for damage; perform simple repairs and make arrangements for complex repairs• Keep the boathouse and club equipment clean and tidy• Help communicate with members through email and SCC social media pages• Monitor boathouse and equipment use and report any problems to the SCC executive• Help member trip-leaders to plan club trips• Other duties as assigned
