# **President: Franny**

Staff update: Importance of identifying yourself as Boathouse Supervisor. Discussion about having shirts made so Boathouse Supervisors are easily identified.

Motion: To approve a budget of up to \$120 to purchase shirts for SCC staff.

Boathouse Supervisor update: Highlights from a report submitted by Shay were the following:

- 50% of time is spent answering emails, updating tour list, checking for duplicate/invalid codes, making posters, and updating calendars.
- 15% giving boathouse tours.
- 5% answering non-member questions.
- 10% tidying the boathouse.
- 10% helping members with equipment questions, membership cards
- 10% boat repairs.
- Group paddles have on average 6 attendees. Skill level varies significantly. We may have to be clear that some paddling experience is a prerequisite to attend group paddle and recommend lessons first to those who don't have any experience.
- Shay is working on a skills checklist for club trip leaders, trip planning and advertising as well as a list of all our canoes and kayaks with their attributes.

Terms for SCC board positions: Discussion on having 3 year terms for board positions. Will revisit this idea closer to the AGM.

ACTION: Franny will speak to Shay and Bryan about shoulder tapping members to to consider filling board positions. Currently we are seeking a Membership Director and Kayak Equipment Manager.

The 4-boat trailer is designed for carrying kayaks. It's too short for canoes and very low to the ground, no box and suspension is missing a bolt. John's opinion is that we should sell it. All agree.

Installed 6 boats with kneepads and purchased 2 sets of thigh straps for whitewater paddling.
