Recreation Update

- had the open house which was successful. Cooked 100 burgers and 36 hotdogs. Estimated 160 participants. Next time will get more hotdogs.
- There were kayak and canoe lessons, all 5 sessions were sold out. Canoe lessons are not doing as great as the kayak lessons. Next year plan with canoe lessons a few days apart from the Kayak lessons. Maybe should advertise more clearly that you can be an individual coming to a canoe clinic, you don't need to be in a pair.
- The recreation group paddle had 10 sessions, average is 8.5. We need more volunteers to lead. Perhaps we will break the group into 2 groups with faster paddlers going ahead and the slower ones staying back with the leader.

Canoe Equipment

- removed 4 canoes to make room for Kayaks
- bought 2 new spray skirts

Marathon update

- 12 boats at group paddle
- Also had some teenaged kids

- Upcoming races we are hosting a race in July 2 days of racing, is clinic and pizza
 night. Usually get a good turnout. The volunteers are scheduled and it shouldn't conflict
 with Prairie Lilly.

Emergency System

Staff have requested an emergency system, Janet looked into this, and a cell phone. We are currently looking at purchasing a google pixel cell with prepaid phone access. This is an issue as some members ask if they can contact the staff if they will be late. Perhaps we will use instant messaging on the Facebook app. OK Alone is a service that we have used, and we are staffing so that staff are spending less time alone on shift. We will use OK Alone again, Lauren will set this up. We should also have a written policy and a hazard assessment.
